

IYTWELEPENTY/DAVENPORT RANGES PART OF THE BINNS TRACK

This National Park overlays a rich living cultural landscape of the Alyawarr, Wakaya, Kaytete and Warumungu traditional owners. Experience the quiet beauty of this park, with access via high clearance 4WD only. Discover European heritage sites from early pastoral and mining days.

Explore this out of the way network of permanent waterholes, and beautiful outback landscapes, on some of the best four-wheel drive tracks in the NT. These tracks criss-cross the 1120 square kilometre park, including a challenging 17-kilometre Frew River loop track to the Old Police Station Waterhole. Stay in the camp sites at the Old Police Station Waterhole or at Whistleduck Creek. Enjoy swimming in the cool waters or just soak up the serenity.

Camping Fees apply -Cash only - No change available onsite

There are only basic camping facilities in the Park so come well prepared. Wood BBQs and Pit Toilets are available. Camping is only permitted in designated camping areas.



Pets are prohibited.

This is an ecologically significant & diverse area so please leave only footprints and respect the water and surrounds.
